GRADUATION & BOOK AWARDS

Senior Awards -2018

The following awards and scholarships were presented to the selected seniors during the graduation ceremony in June 2018.

Valedictorian Award

The Valedictorian Award was established to honor the senior with the highest GPA in his/her class. This \$1000 scholarship was given to Zachary Dickerson.

Salutatorian Award

The Salutatorian Award is given to the senior with the second highest GPA in his/her class. This \$500 scholarship was given to Molly Morgan.

Walter Gannon Scholarship

The Walter Gannon Diocesan Scholarship is a one-time scholarship to help defray academic costs for the first year of college. The criteria for this award include high level of scholarship and concern for others. The recipient of this \$1,500 scholarship was Kathryn Long.



Knight's Honor Scholarship

The Knight's Honor Scholarship is dedicated to recognizing a deserving Blessed Sacrament Huguenot Catholic School senior with a proven record of helping others within their community. The re-

cipient must demonstrate outstanding leadership skills, distinguished moral principles and have a strong academic standing. uKnighted will fund a one-time \$2,500 scholarship as evidence of their commitment to cultivating lifelong learning and to encouraging our young people's service to God and Humanity. The recipient of this scholarship was Colby Johnson.

Principal's Award

The Principal's Award is a one-time scholarship given to a senior chosen by the Head of School. This \$250 award was given to Catherine Ruskan.

Faculty Award

The Faculty Award is a one-time \$250 award given to a senior who has positively contributed to the community culture of Blessed Sacrament Huguenot. This award is voted on by the entire staff and faculty. This scholarship was given to Erin Claud.

Junior Book Awards-2018

The Jefferson Book Award is presented to a junior who best represents the Jeffersonian ideals of scholarship, leadership and citizenship. The award consists of a book titled "Quotable Jefferson" and a personalized certificate signed by President Teresa Sullivan. The 2018 recipient of the Jefferson Book Award was Cameron Hipps.

The John Merchant Book Award

recognizes the high school junior who best exemplifies a dedication to increasing and improving diversity in his or her school community. Award recipients are selected on the basis of their contributions to promoting harmony and equality among persons of all races, religions, creeds and cultures and are given John Merchant's autobiography titled, "A Journey Worth Taking: An Unpredictable Adventure." The 2018 recipient of the John Merchant Book Award was Caroline Murphy.

The Randolph-Macon College Leadership Award is given to a junior who is an excellent student academically and enrolled in a solid college preparatory program. The recipient should be a well-rounded individual who excels in the classroom and is also an active participant in extracurricular activities, especially in leadership roles. The student recipient will be automatically eligible to receive a merit scholarship of at least \$15,000 per year. The 2018 Randolph-Macon College Leadership Award was given to Kemper Roudabush.

The Richmond Alumnae Panhellenic Book Award is presented to a female in the junior class with community involvement, philanthropic service, positive attitude, scholarship achievement and strong leadership skills. The 2018 recipient of this award was Bevan Fichter.

is given to a high school junior who is academically strong and who is a leader outside of the classroom. Any student who receives the Randolph College Book Award is automatically considered for a merit scholarship of at least \$5,000 per year if he/she applies and is accepted for admission to the College. The William and Mary Leader**ship Award** is presented to one outstanding member of the junior class. This award is intended to recognize young leaders in their community. The recipient receives a certificate as well as a copy of the book, "A Passion for Leadership." The leadership award is given to a student who exemplifies school spirit, is highly involved in extracurricular activities, has a strong academic record, is an innovative thinker, and has earned the respect of teachers. 


